This project promotes and maintains the function and diversity of the ecosystems along the Niagara Escarpment while protecting forest cover in areas where local dynamics (e.g. logging, mineral extraction, severances, etc.) increase pressures on land and wildlife.

The Niagara escarpment stretches from Niagara Falls towards Tobermory, and extends along Manitoulin Island. All managed trails are directed far away from featured species in the area, such as Pileated Woodpeckers, Great Grey Owls and Painted Turtles

The Escarpment Biosphere Conservancy (EBC) is Ontario's largest and Canada's second largest land conservation agency, dedicated to preserving natural systems. Conditions within the properties managed by EBC vary significantly and range from very productive forestland, to open grasslands, to Alvar conditions with shallow soils. The EBC is a registered charity whose mission is to maintain, enhance or restore areas of native species or natural habitat, and to encourage and support scientific research and educational services related thereto.
